

What are your camp hours?

For regular Emmanuel Day Camp, our camp runs from 9:00am - 4:30pm. For Emmanuel Day Camp from Aug 4-7, our camp runs from 9:00am - 3:30pm.

Camp is full and I didn't get in! What can I do now?

Often there will be a few cancellations, so we take waitlists for each week! To have your child(ren) put on the waitlist, you can call the church office (204) 326-9865 or email us at day.camp@eefc.ca.

My child is eligible for different weeks. Can I pick which one they attend?

Yes you can! Kids entering Grades 1-3 are eligible to participate in any week! You can choose which camp they attend based off of their friends/siblings or just which camp you think would work best for them!

Why do you cap your weeks?

We are limited to a certain number of campers each week for two reasons: Firstly, we do outings as part of our week, so we are limited by how many kids we can transport. Secondly, we have to maintain a staff-to-camper ratio to help keep everyone safe!

My child wants to be in a group with their friends. Is that possible?

Most of the time, we can ensure that your child is able to be with their friends. We do our best to guarantee ONE friend request per child but cannot promise more than that. There is a space on the registration form to add a friend request!

What does my child need everyday?

We ask that campers come everyday with a hat, running shoes, a packed lunch, a water bottle, swimsuit & towel. We will include a list of these 'Everyday Items' on your Camper Information Packet that gets sent out one week before you come to Day Camp!

Can I send nuts to camp with my child?

Emmanuel Day Camp is a **nut-free** program. Please avoid sending any products containing nuts with your child.

I would like my child to wear a lifejacket while swimming (Weeks #1,2,3).

Absolutely! You are welcome to send your own lifejacket with your child. We will ensure that they are wearing it whenever they are in the water.

My child has special dietary concerns. Are there options for them?

Yes! We have snacks available for gluten/dairy free children. Please indicate the need on the registration form and we will work with you to determine what they can/cannot eat with the snacks that we provide.

How do you get to your outings?

Emmanuel Day Camp uses a school bus to go on our Winnipeg outing. We ask parents or Emmanuel congregants to help with our local outings. All drivers must have a valid drivers license and current vehicle insurance. We do not exceed the number of seatbelts that are in each vehicle and there is an Emmanuel Day Camp staff person in each vehicle. If you have more concerns about your child's safety on field trips, feel free to contact us.

What is your refund policy?

All registration cancellations are subject to a \$25 administration fee per camper.

If a cancellation is made up to 2 weeks before the start date of camp you registered for, we can offer a refund of 50% of your registration fees.

Registration cancellations occurring within 2 weeks of the start date of your child's week of camp may not be refunded.

If you need to switch weeks for any reason, it is free until June 15 (subject to availability)! After June 15 switching weeks can be subject to a \$50 admin fee.

Do you offer any funding for kids to go to camp?

Yes, we do! We have a Camper Sponsorship Program that provides funding for kids to go to camp, if needed. To apply for this program, or for more information, please email pam.friesen@eefc.ca.
